

Ngati Maru Tupuna List (Updated 22 Sept 2014)

Attached is a list of Ngati Maru (ki Taranaki) ancestors. The list has been compiled based on research and consultation undertaken by Karl Burrows and Pare Hayward in 2014, and is being used by Te Runanga o Ngati Maru as a basis to determine eligibility to be on the Ngati Maru Tribal Register. The research methodology, or rationale, is explained as follows:

Rationale for Inclusion of Tupuna

Rohe

The research focused on documents relating to land within Te Rohe o Ngati Maru (as defined by Matua Pono Whakaruru), and Maori on the Western Maori Electoral Rolls of 1908 and 1919. It was considered this focus would yield the most expansive list of Maru tupuna within the research funding available. However, we acknowledge the need for further research to examine land blocks and electoral rolls from across the Taranaki region more broadly.

Time Period

The Tupuna List comprises a “snapshot” of tupuna from the above documents relating to the historical era of 1880 - 1920. For the same reason as above, this focus was applied in order to yield the maximum collection of Maru tupuna with the limited funding available. Again, we acknowledge the need to extend the research beyond this time period for possible future inclusion of additional Maru tupuna.

Identity – Mana Tangata

This goes to the heart of the rationale for inclusion of tupuna on the list. The approach taken was to include only those tupuna who identified themselves as Ngati Maru or for whom the historical evidence clearly indicates a collective Maru “take” (claim or entitlement to land) with no evidence of other iwi involvement or cross claims.

Where there is evidence of other iwi involvement or that individuals were claiming rights to land within the Maru rohe based on descent from other iwi or hapu (eg Ngati Tanewai, Ngaruahine, Ngati Ruanui, Te Atiawa etc) these tupuna have not been included. Hence the approach taken to define our Ngati Maru claimant identity can be described as Mana Tangata (in the sense that a person’s stated identity is the defining factor) as opposed to whether or not they were successful in being awarded land interests in any particular block.

Work in Progress

We acknowledge that this Tupuna List is a “work in progress”. We encourage those who believe their ancestor should be included to contact us to discuss this, as a process exists where new tupuna can be added based on historical evidence of Maru identity. On that

note, this updated list includes 18 additional tupuna, four of whom were approved by the Runanga based on submissions from whanau, and 14 were added with the inclusion of Pohokura Block (which should have been covered in the original report).

Duplicate entries have been removed (eg where a tupuna was included twice under two different names but new historical evidence indicates they are the same person). Recent additions (i.e, the 18 tupuna referred to above) are grouped in non-alphabetical order at the end of the list:
